

## **Dress Code - Men**

this dress code guide serves as a suggestion to help participants align with the professional atmosphere of the conference. While deviations to some degree are respected, we strongly recommend adhering to at least a business casual dress code to maintain a cohesive and professional environment. ## **Business attire**

Business attire is the dress code during the official conference sessions (including opening and closing ceremonies, formal and informal sessions).

General remarks:	<ul> <li>Discreet, simple and elegant</li> <li>Well-groomed appearance, ironed shirts and suits</li> <li>Put long hair out of your face, plait</li> <li>Well-groomed beard or cleanly shaved</li> <li>Well-fitting clothes look professional and calm</li> </ul>
Suit	<ul> <li>Colors: dark blue, black, grey</li> <li>Preferably plain: light, discreet pattern at maximum</li> <li>The higher the occasion, the darker the color</li> <li>Optional vest</li> </ul>
Shirt	<ul> <li>Long sleeves</li> <li>Kent collar or cut away collar</li> <li>Subtle colors, no patterns</li> <li>Match shirt color with suit, shirt lighter than suit</li> <li>Cufflinks are optional, subtle design</li> </ul>
Tie	<ul> <li>Darker than shirt, match color with suit (not more than 2 colors in outfit)</li> <li>Choose tie knot in accordance with shirt collar (cut away collar → bigger knot, Kent collar → smaller knot)</li> <li>Tip of tie at belt hight when standing up</li> <li>No fancy tie knots</li> <li>No bowties</li> </ul>
Shoes	<ul> <li>Dark leather shoes with dark soles (black or brown)</li> <li>Color matching with belt and watch</li> <li>No sneakers / boat shoes etc.</li> </ul>

Socks	<ul> <li>Color match with suit (dark blue suit → dark blue socks, black suit → black socks)</li> <li>No short socks, legs must be covered when sitting</li> <li>Socks may be fancy (e.g. subtle Happy Socks) or matching shirt / tie</li> </ul>
Accessoire	<ul> <li>Obligatory leather belt</li> <li>Match belt color with shoes and watch</li> <li>Subtle belt buckle</li> <li>Match wristband of your watch with belt and shoes</li> <li>Rings / bracelets allowed (five item rule)</li> </ul>
Bag	<ul> <li>Leather bag matching with shoes / belt / watch</li> <li>Subtle laptop bags</li> <li>No backpacks or linen bags</li> </ul>
Possible tie knots	<ul> <li>Single Windsor:</li> <li>Double Windsor:</li> <li>Kent:</li> </ul>

## **Business Casual**

- No tie needed, More casual, but elegant clothes
- More colorful and lighter clothing allowed, patterns allowed, still subtle, simple and elegant - Jacket is optional, pullover on top of shirt also allowed
- Regular pants or chinos (no chino shorts), no jeans
- Shirt:
  - Business, Button Down, Kent Collar shirts, long sleeve mandatory (no short sleeve shirts) • Shoes:
  - clean leather shoes, wingtip shoes, white clean sneakers or elegant slippers (no boat shoes)
     Socks may be fancy, but not too extravagant
- Leather belt matching with shoes and watch
